

Notice regarding the new § 4 a TestV (citizen testing)

According to § 4 a TestV (citizen testing) the following persons (groups) are entitled to free testing:

Exclusively the following asymptomatic persons (groups) are entitled to free testing:

1. children up to and including 5 years of age.
2. persons who cannot be vaccinated against SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus at the time of testing due to a medical contraindication, in particular pregnancy in the first trimester, or who could not be vaccinated against SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus in the three months prior to testing due to a medical contraindication,
3. Individuals who are participating in clinical trials of SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus vaccine efficacy at the time of testing or have participated in such trials in the three months prior to testing,
4. Individuals who are in segregation due to confirmed SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus infection at the time of testing, if testing is required to end segregation,
5. When required by the following named facilities or entities* or the Public Health Service to prevent the spread of SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus, asymptomatic persons are eligible for testing if they
 - 5.1. are currently being treated, cared for, maintained, or housed there, or
 - 5.2. wish to visit a person being treated, cared for, maintained, or housed there.
6. persons² who will
 - 6.1. attend an indoor event or
 - 6.2. have contact with a person who
 - 6.2.1. is 60 years of age or older or
 - 6.2.2. is at high risk of severe COVID-19 due to a pre-existing condition or disability,
7. persons² who have received a warning with a status indication of increased risk through the Robert Koch Institute's Corona Warning App,
8. Beneficiaries who employ persons within the framework of a personal budget according to § 29 of the Ninth Book of the Social Code, as well as persons who are employed by beneficiaries within the framework of a personal budget according to § 29 of the Ninth Book of the Social Code³,
9. caregivers in the sense of § 19 sentence 1 of the Eleventh Book of the Social Code,
10. persons who live in the same household with a person infected with the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus.

ties, treatment or care facilities comparable to any of the previously mentioned facilities, medical practices, dental practices, practices of other human medical professions, public health service facilities in which medical examinations, preventive measures or outpatient treatment are performed, outpatient nursing services providing intensive outpatient care in institutions, residential groups or other community living arrangements, and emergency medical services. Preventive and rehabilitation facilities, even if no medical care comparable to hospitals is provided there, inpatient facilities and outpatient services for integration assistance

2 In the case of tests in accordance with numbers 6 and 7, the person to be tested must pay a personal contribution of 3 euros to the service provider. The KvBaWue will pay €4 for the test smear.

3 Persons with disabilities

4 Caregivers within the meaning of this book are persons who do not gainfully care for a person in need of care within the meaning of § 14 in his or her home environment.

Proof of eligibility for testing

1. Persons over 18 years of age must present an official photo ID (identity card or passport). Persons under 18 years of age another official photo identification.

2. proof that the persons are entitled to testing according to the above mentioned reasons (testing according to § 4 a TestV (citizen testing)). a. In case 2 (the medical contraindication), an original medical certificate must be provided. b. In case 10 (household member), a proof of the positive test result and of the same residential address.

3. in the case of number 6 and 7, a self-declaration of the person to be tested must be submitted that a test according to number 6 or 7 is/was carried out with a personal contribution of 3 euros. This self-disclosure must be kept until 31.12.2024, just like the other data to be documented.

Obligation to provide proof

Since it is impossible for us to effectively check whether you are really entitled to a free or reduced-price test according to § 4 a TestV, we must ask you, in accordance with good order, to affirm here in lieu of an oath (self-disclosure) that you are entitled to receive such a free (or reduced-price) test here today. If you have any questions, our staff will be happy to assist you at any time. Do not hesitate to ask. We would like to point out that a false assurance could possibly constitute an offense under § 156 of the German Criminal Code (StGB).
